Team Reps are essential in creating an organized, positive, and supportive environment for players, coaches, and families. They serve as a key liaison and representative of Springwater United Soccer Academy.

Key Responsibilities

Player-Centered Support

- Support a positive, safe, and inclusive environment for all players.
- Always prioritize the well-being of players in all team-related decisions and interactions.

Communication & Organization

- Act as the primary point of contact between coaches, parents, and the academy.
- Communicate schedules, updates, and important information in a timely and professional manner.
- Assist with team logistics including game schedules, tournaments, and events.

Respect for Officials & Opponents

- Demonstrate respect for referees, opponents, and all participants at all times.
- Never engage in or encourage negative behaviour toward officials or opposing teams.

Sideline Conduct

- Promote a positive sideline environment for players and spectators.
- Address inappropriate behaviour calmly and respectfully when necessary.
- Support the coach's decisions and ensure parents respect team standards.

Support for Coaches & Academy Philosophy

- Work collaboratively with coaches to support training sessions, matches, and team operations.
- Follow and uphold the academy's philosophy, values, and methodology at all times.

Fairness & Respect

- Treat all players, families, and staff with fairness, respect, and professionalism.
- Encourage inclusion, teamwork, and a strong sense of community.

Disciplinary Action

Failure to adhere to this Code of Conduct—including inappropriate behaviour toward players, parents, officials, or staff—may result in disciplinary action. This can include warnings, suspension, or removal from the team/academy.
